Tséhootsooí Medical Center COVID-19 Drive-up Clinic (Vaccines & Testing) Adjusted Hours. COVID Testing (ONLY) on Saturday, Sunday and Labor Day.

FORT DEFIANCE, AZ, - Tséhootsooí Medical Center's (TMC) COVID-19 Vaccine and Testing Drive-up Clinic is adjusting its hours of operation to meet the increased request for COVID-19 testing. Please note the adjustments below:

- **Monday – Friday:** 9 a.m. – 12 p.m. & 1 p.m. – 7 p.m.
- **Saturday and Sunday:** 10 a.m. – 1 p.m. for **COVID-19 Testing ONLY** (no COVID vaccinations)
- **Holiday Hours:** 10 a.m. – 1 p.m. for **COVID-19 Testing ONLY** (no COVID vaccinations)

The COVID-19 Drive-up Clinic is currently administering 1st and 2nd vaccine doses ONLY. 3rd Booster doses for immunocompromised individuals are **not available at the Drive-up Clinic**. TMC Primary Care Clinic will be administering 3rd dose booster vaccines to patients that meet immunocompromised criteria. TMC Primary Care Clinic will be contacting these individuals by phone in the coming days.

Important Information:

- All children **MUST** be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian.
 - Legal guardians **MUST** present guardianship papers or official court documents of guardianship.
- Individuals receiving their 2nd dose are required to provide their Vaccination Record Card to the attending vaccination team.
- Individuals who receive a COVID-19 test will be required to isolate until results are communicated by TMC Public Health Nursing.

The COVID 19 Vaccine is **not** recommended for patients who have the following:

- Individuals younger than 12 years old at the date of vaccination for Pfizer vaccine.
- Individuals younger than 18 years old at the date of vaccination for Moderna Vaccine.
- Have cough, fever, shortness of breath or loss of taste or smell, or any other illness.
- Are currently in isolation for positive COVID-19 test results
- Are currently in quarantine for a household member with COVID-19 or an exposure to a person who has COVID-19.
- Currently waiting to receive COVID-19 test results.
