FORT DEFIANCE, AZ, - Fort Defiance Indian Hospital Board, Inc. (FDIHB) continues to provide COVID-19 vaccinations. At Tséhootsooí Medical Center a COVID-19 Vaccine and Testing Drive-up Clinic has been established and is available for individuals seeking to get their first and second dose of available Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines. COVID-19 testing available to all ages.

Important Information:

- All children **MUST** be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian.
 - Legal guardians **MUST** present guardianship papers or official court documents of guardianship.
- Individuals receiving their 2nd dose are required to provide their Vaccination Record Card to the attending vaccination team.
- Individuals who receive a COVID-19 test will be required to isolate until results are communicated by TMC Public Health Nursing.



The Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine is currently the only COVID-19 vaccine authorized for individuals 12 years old and older. The COVID 19 Vaccine is **not** recommended for patients who have the following:

- Individuals younger than 12 years old at the date of vaccination for Pfizer vaccine.
- Individuals younger than 18 years old at the date of vaccination for Moderna Vaccine.
- Have cough, fever, shortness of breath or loss of taste or smell, or any other illness.
- Are currently in isolation for positive COVID-19 test results
- Are currently in quarantine for a household member with COVID-19 or an exposure to a person who has COVID-19.
- Currently waiting to receive COVID-19 test results.
