# COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic Moving from Nihi Dine'É Bá Wellness Center to Tséhootsooí Medical Center Primary Care Clinic Beginning March 14, 2022

FORT DEFIANCE, AZ – Beginning March 14, 2022, COVID-19 Vaccines will no longer be offered at Nihi Dine'É Bá Wellness Center (NDBWC) and will be moved to Tséhootsooí Medical Center (TMC) Primary Care Clinic. Appointment slots will be available on Tuesdays & Thursdays, 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. Appointments can be made by calling Primary Care Clinic at 928-729-8032

Each individual will be required to wear a face mask & receive a brief health screening upon entering any Fort Defiance Indian Hospital Board facility.
